



INFORMED CONSENT FORM FOR THE EUROPEAN LIVER TRANSPLANT REGISTRY (ELTR)

Information

We invite you to participate in the ELTR, which is the European prospective database with over 170 centres and 31 participating countries. The main objective is to gather and analyse data of all liver transplants performed in Europe in order to improve management and transplant patient care. Your privacy is important to us, and we want to communicate with our patients in a way that obtains their consent and is compliant with the European General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR). Your medical care will be carried out as usual by your health care team. Your doctor will collect clinical and biological data useful for your care and follow-up. He will be able to answer any questions you may have. Before any transmission, your medical data will be encrypted and pseudo-anonymized (code number and initials) to ensure confidentiality. You have the right to access and rectify. You also have the right to object to the transmission of data covered by professional secrecy. You are free to accept or refuse to participate. You can end your participation at any time without having to explain your choice, and this would not affect your relationship with your doctor.

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
