- Conclusion**
- The ELTR is often used by 71% of participants
 - 81% of participants judge the ELTR as very useful (indispensable for 26%)
 - 69% consider ELTR information as main
 - 70% report that the ELTR is often mentioned in the congresses or in the literature
 - 94% consider ELTR data as good (excellent for 31%)
 - 70% think that the ELTR is really representative
